3 Nathu La:

Once part of the Silk Route, Nathu La, at an elevation of 14,450 feet is renowned for its diverse alpine flora and fauna. The road to Nathu La is one of the highest motorable roads in India, passing through Tsomgo Lake on its way.

4 Himalayan Zoological Park:

Home to the elusive red panda - the cuddly state animal, barking deer, Himalayan black bear and others.

5 Pal Zurmang Kagyud (Ranka) Monastery:

Located at Lingdum village, it was built by the present Gharwang Rinpoche who is the 12th incarnate of Zurmang Gharwang.

Some foodie delights

Gangtok's local cuisine is a vast mix of taste and flavours. Begin with delicious **momos**, found everywhere from roadside shacks to costly restaurants. Gobble these steamed flour dumplings stuffed with minced meat, cheese or vegetables with a dollop of chilli sauce. Beat the cold with a warm bowl of delicious soup. Choose **Thukpa**, a common Tibetan style noodle soup, prepared with vegetables and meat or **Sishnu Soup**, a unique local dish, prepared from leaves of edible wild nettle. Polish off some **Sel Roti**, a ring-shaped, deep-fried bread, prepared from fermented rice with some yummy potato curry or meat. Next, try **Kinema** or fermented soybean, a tasty side dish consumed with rice. Snack on **Tama** or fresh bamboo shoots used to prepare delicious pork curry or give your meal a zing with **Mesu**, a conventional fermented bamboo shoot item utilised to make achar or pickles. Afterwards, wash down your meal with **Chhaang** or a fermented cereal-based alcoholic drink served in a bamboo container.
